

## NOTICE TO PATRONS

We have determined that your actions this day are in violation of the Computer Access and Internet Access Policy of the Nanuet Public Library, a copy of which is attached to this notice. You are directed to immediately remove from public display any and all materials which violate the policy of the Nanuet Public Library concerning inappropriate materials as judged by the community standards of the Hamlet of Nanuet, Town of Clarkstown, and County of Rockland. Please be further advised that we have indicated by check mark the specific concerns which we hereby raise concerning inappropriate materials.

- (i) Indications of a hate group or groups dedicated to illegal discrimination; or
- (ii) Sexually explicit materials, which exhibit private parts of the human anatomy (female breasts, male or female genitalia) in a lurid and prurient manner; or
- (iii) Which displays pornography or child pornography or other graphic materials or language which would violate the laws of the United States or the State of New York; or
- (iv) Displays bodily functions or bodily injury or physical harm to humans or animals in a vulgar or gross manner.

Please be further advised that you are directed on the basis of using a computer device in violation of the foregoing standards to leave the Library for the remainder of the Library's business day. Please be advised that the Library's business day closes at \_\_\_\_\_ today.

Please be further advised that if you fail and refuse to comply with the policy which we hereby deliver to you as attached, your rights to use a computer device may be suspended for a period of six (6) months, or in the event of multiple violations, for additional periods of one (1) year each.

If you have any questions, you are directed to contact the Library's Board of Trustees c/o the Nanuet Public Library, in writing, to register any appeal or complaint.
