

VOLUNTEERS - POLICY

Volunteer opportunities are available to students in 7th grade through high school who have community service obligations through a school or religious affiliation. Students must reside in the Nanuet School District or attend a school or religious institution located in the Nanuet School District. It is understood that volunteer opportunities are dependent on the library's need for help, the existence of appropriate tasks, and the availability of staff to train and supervise. Preference will be given to students who reside in the Nanuet School District.

Volunteer work will generally be done in two-hour increments at the convenience of the library. Other arrangements can be made if the task demands it, with the permission of a Librarian or the Director.

Additional volunteer opportunities are available through membership in the Friends of the Library and the Teen Advisory Board. General volunteer opportunities through the Library are occasionally available depending on need and the availability of staff to train and supervise.
